Acknowledgement of Receipt:

A plaque will be printed to recognize Dave's contribution to the district and placed in the northeast corner of the gym where he always used to stand. Recognition of the plaque will take place at graduation or a student assembly.

Computers and Technology Items:

Committee wanted to see the items used by students rather than sold. District is researching what it would take to make these units network compatible. The district will need to clear any personal information off machines before placed in use. Computers may be used as stand-alone units that are not tied into existing network.

Manufactured Home Sale:

The district received three bids after second round of advertising. First bidder has already been rejected by trailer park owner due to lack of income history. The same may happen with the other two bidders. District will follow due diligence in attempting to place one of the bidders. Previous school board discussion and committee discussion indicate that if bidders are rejected, the district remove the trailer from the site rather than allow trailer park owner to take possession.

Weapon Recovery:

District has not had good response from Linn County district attorney or evidence room officer to indicate if case has been released and items are ready for pickup. Once case is cleared, weapons can be recovered and will be sold as one lot to a local licensed gun buyer.

Use of Remaining Funds:

Bank balance as of March 6, 2014, was \$46,000. Discussion of using funds in alternating years for elementary and high school performing arts needs. Ideas include arts program at elementary or full stage production at high school. Instrumental music program was also considered. Committee continues to seek community guidance on the best use of these funds.
