

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS NOVEMBER 10, 2014

SUPERINTENDENT AWARDS:

Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for November were: Angus and Audrey Smith, first grade; Triniti Reese, fifth grade; Grace Glenn, eighth grade; and Pascual Figueroa, tenth grade.

ACTION:

- Approved minutes of the October 13th, school board meeting as submitted.
- Acknowledged staff changes as follows: hired Rhonda Cutler and Wanda Davidson as temporary, part-time, educational assistants for the remainder of the 2014-15 school year to work at the elementary school.
- Approved Oregon School Board Association Resolution #1 to adopt the proposed 2015 OSBA Legislative Policies and Priorities; Resolution #2 to amend the OSBA Constitution - technical corrections to modify the process for the adoption of OSBA's Legislative Policies; and Resolution #3 to amend the OSBA Constitution to allow appointment of OSBA Board and Legislative Policy Committee members from a contiguous region if certain conditions are met.

BUSINESS:

- The Board still looking to fill the Budget Committee vacancy representing Zone 5, south Brownsville. Applications may be found on the district's website or contacting the district office.
- Reviewed the results of the community survey sent to every household in the district. The return was minimal, out of 3500 mailed there were 64 non-employee returns and seven employee returns.

OTHER:

- Booster Club has approved \$15,637 towards an automated reader board for the high school.
- Transportation office has moved back to the high school from the Brownsville location.
- Renovation on the white house has started for relocating the district office staff back to the high school campus from the Brownsville site.
