

SCHOOL BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS JUNE 8, 2015

SUPERINTENDENT AWARDS:

Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for June are: Matthew Blount, third grade; Bren Schneiter, fourth grade; Havyn Looper, sixth grade; Gracie Robb, seventh grade; and Charlotte Forrest, eleventh grade.

ACTION:

- Opened budget hearing; no public testimony or discussion; hearing closed.
- Approved minutes of the May 11, 2015, school board meeting.
- Acknowledged approval of budget committee meeting (by mail ballot) of May 18, 2015.
- Approved Resolution 6-01-15, Transfer of Appropriations, authorizing a general fund transfer of \$115,000 appropriation from Interfund Transfers Function 5200 to Support Services Function 2000 and \$55,000 from Contingency Function 6000 to Community Services Function 3000 to cover final expenditures.
- Adopted Resolution 6-02-2015, Adopting the 2015-16 Budget; Resolution 6-03-2015 Making Appropriations; and Resolution 6-04-2015 Imposing and Categorizing Taxes-Combined.
- Acknowledged the resignations of Dena Ganieany, Elementary Secretary, Justin Smith, Varsity Boys' Basketball Coach and Bart Rothenberger, Director of Facilities/A.D.
- Approved the hire of elementary teachers, Debbie Bishop and Amanda Christie.
- Accepted the certified results of the Special Election of May 19th, electing school board members David Goracke, Zone 1; George Frasier, Zone 2; Parker Leigh, Zone 3; Mark Penrod, Zone 5.
- Revised Superintendent Gardner's contract to include language "All writings, presentations, and other materials generated by the Superintendent will remain the property of the Superintendent. The Superintendent shall not exclude Central Linn School District from the implementation or use of principles and techniques generated during the superintendents hire." Also, "Superintendent may request to receive pay for up to five (5) days of vacation per year."
