March 13, 2017

COMMUNICATION

- Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for March were: Adam Erickson, second grade; Emily Beach, fourth grade; Kiera Hollister, seventh grade; and Maddie Neuschwander, eleventh grade.
- It was reported Anette Carroll would be taking 12 elementary students to Space Camp for a week in June! Also, Blue Notes will be performing at the Seattle Center Armory as part of the Whirligig Festival next month. While in Seattle they will receive a vocal class and tour at the Experience Music Project, see a performance of a large-scale musical theater production and on the return trip attend a clinic at Portland State University from their vocal jazz instructor.

BOARD ACTION

- Approved second year probationary administrator contract for Robyn Bailey.
- Adopted school board policies as revised: AC, Non-Discrimination, and Administrative Rule; GBDA, Mother Friendly Workplace; and GBM, Staff Complaints.
- Acknowledged the summary of Superintendent Gardner's evaluation.
