COMMUNICATION

Each month, teachers may nominate students for the Superintendent's Award. The award is given in recognition of outstanding personal accomplishments. Recipients for October were: Casey Carter, first grade; Jackson Duringer, fourth grade; Gemma Rowland, seventh grade; and Jessica Neal, eleventh grade.

Pioneer Picnic Association donated \$2,000 for the Central Linn Track Fund. These proceeds came from the annual Pioneer Dam Run held during Pioneer Picnic. The donation is placed in a designated account to be used specifically for a new track.

Kirt Glenn reported the community track committee continues to meet every two weeks. The Committee is exploring different large fundraising projects and grants. One estimate for a new track came in at \$700,000.
