Central Linn School District is a 550 student K-12 district for four unique communities of Halsey, Brownsville, Shedd, and Peoria and is nestled in the beautiful Willamette Valley, bounded by the Cascade Mountains on the east and the Coastal Range on the west. Ninety minutes in either direction will get you to the coast or the mountains. Our immediate vicinity is the “grass seed capital of the world” whose fields offer a colorful, ever-changing seasonal array of grass fields interspersed with sheep, cattle, vineyards and hazelnut orchards. Central Linn is also conveniently located within thirty minutes of Corvallis, Eugene, and within two hours of Bend and Portland.

JOB SUMMARY:

Create a vibrant learning community for children and to educate the whole child intellectually, emotionally, and physically. Central Linn High School is in renovation to be equipped with: a welding shop, wood shop, animal barn, greenhouse, land lab, chapter farm and the standard classroom setting that will be available to this teacher. The chosen candidate must have knowledge of CTE approved program of study, specifically agriculture standards, understanding the role and function of FFA, and supervision of agricultural experiences (SAE) is desirable. Central Linn has a strong FFA Alumni and Advisory Committee, the chosen candidate will be asked to establish good relations with parents, students, and staff; attend all pertinent faculty, parent and school meetings; other duties as assigned.

- Bachelor’s Degree or higher.
- Hold or be eligible to obtain Oregon Teaching Certification with required Agriculture Science and Agriculture Science and Technology (CTE) endorsements.
- Perform FFA Advisory Duties - stipends available.
- Coach the Career Development Education (CDE) Teams
- Attend FFA meetings, conventions and livestock shows including those scheduled out of the area.
- Ability to establish positive working relationships with students, staff, and parents.
