1. Providing buildings and renovations that will accommodate and facilitate those organizational and instructional patterns that support the district's educational mission, philosophy and instructional goals;
2. Meeting all safety requirements through the remodeling of older facilities;
3. Providing building renovations as needed to meet requirements on the accessibility and usability of facilities to persons with disabilities;
4. Building design, construction and renovation that will allow low maintenance costs and the conservation of energy.
