

Non-School Employment

All employees are expected to devote their time and energy to accomplishing those tasks required by the district. Employees should avoid outside employment that interferes with the performance of their responsibilities and the maintenance of productive relationships with students, parents, and other staff members. If outside employment or activities interferes with job performance the employee will be required to make a choice between district employment and outside employment or activities.

Under no circumstances shall a district employee use personal or other leave to provide paid service to another public employer.
