Student Drug Testing Policy

DEFINITIONS:

Drug: Any substance considered illegal by Oregon Statute or which is controlled by the

Food and Drug Administration.

Student Participant: Any student participating in co-curricular and/or interscholastic athletic programs

sponsored by the Central Linn School District, including cheerleaders, dance team

members, and Student Body Officers.

Sport Session: Fall, Winter, and Spring seasons begin on the first day of practice allowed by the

Oregon School Activities Association and end the day prior to the beginning date

of practice of the next season.

Policy Statement:

Central Linn School District #552-C (the district) conducts a random mandatory drug testing program for student participants. Its purpose is threefold: (1) to provide for the health and safety of all student participants; (2) to undermine the effects of peer pressure by providing a legitimate reason for students to refuse to use illegal drugs; and (3) to encourage students who use drugs to participate in drug treatment programs. The superintendent will maintain the appropriate administrative rule to carry out this policy.
