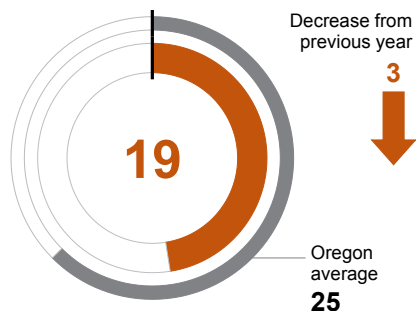

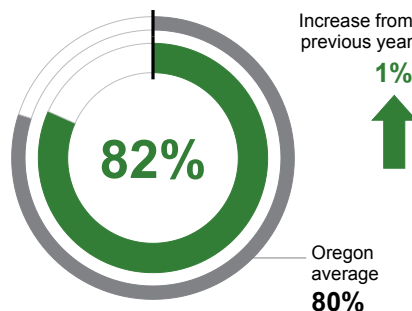
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

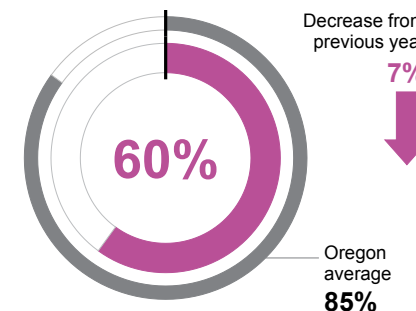
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

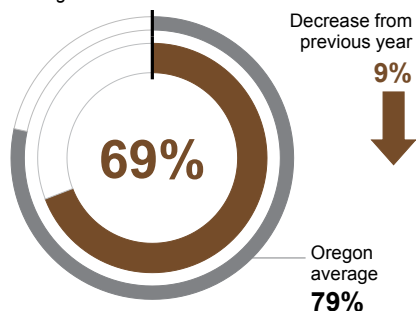
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

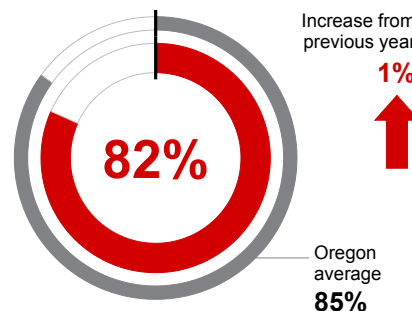
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2014-15.



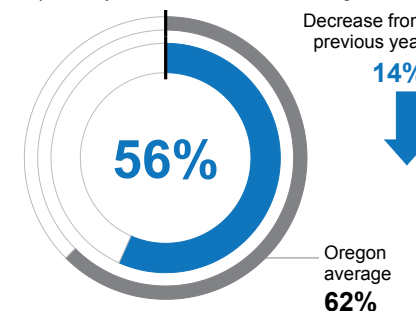
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

Our goals for the 2019-20 school year are: Improve students organizational skills, Increase academic achievement in grades 7-12. To help meet these goals, we have improved summer school, implemented interventions for students, are moving towards implementing AVID school-wide, and will continue to offer *Friday School* throughout the year.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

Students are the focus of our school. We are implementing Restorative Practices throughout our school to give students the tools needed to prevent and effectively deal with conflict. We have a full-time certified counselor on campus to support our students. Changes in parent-teacher conference format, grading periods, and improvements in school-to-parent communication have been made to welcome parents on campus throughout the school year.

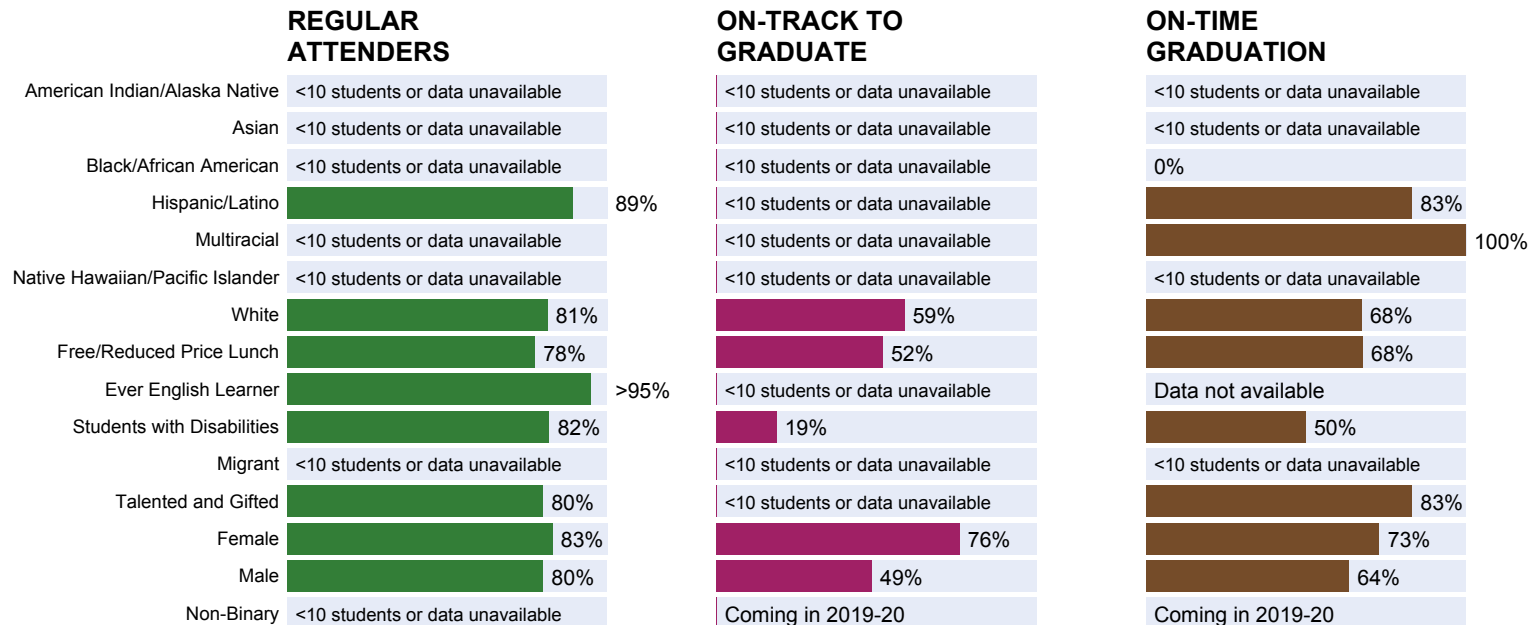
