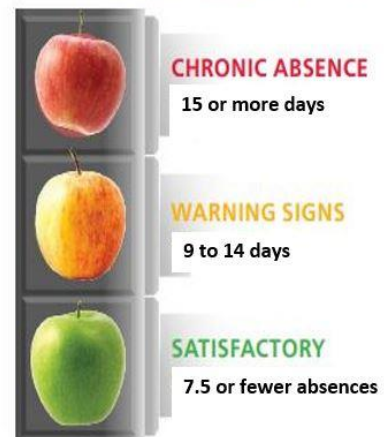
If you have moved, changed mailing address, changed a phone number or have different primary contact information, PLEASE contact the office immediately to update your information.

DID YOU KNOW?

Chronic absenteeism, a primary cause of poor academic achievement, **is defined as missing at least 10 percent of days in a school year for any reason, including excused and unexcused absences.**

In our District, we have 151 instructional days, missing 15 or more days is considered chronically absent.
