# Central Linn Memorial Scholarship Scholarship Application

To be eligible for the Central Linn Memorial Scholarship, applicants must be seniors at Central Linn High School. Scholarships are awarded annually for a one-year period and must be used during the course of the following school year. Scholarships are awarded each year. This will be a one-time award of \$1000.00 for 6 seniors.

A check will be forwarded to the college after proof of enrollment from the registrar. Special arrangements may be made so that the Memorial scholarship can be reserved for one full school year upon written request of the recipient by September 1<sup>st</sup> of that school year. These funds will be credited to the student's account and may be spent on any college expenses (example: tuition, books, supplies, etc.).

### The Applicant must:

- Have been accepted at a four-year college/university, OR have been accepted to a community, technical or vocation college and have graduated from High School in good standing.
- 2. Have declared a career interest
- 3. Application forms can be picked up at the Career Center and include:
  - a. 2 letters of recommendation from non-relatives
  - b. Prepare a statement concerning his/her career goal or aspiration
- 4. Agree to carry a minimum of 12 credits while attending a 4 year college OR a minimum of 9 credits if attending a community, technical or vocational college
