Students graduating this June with a 3.0 or higher GPA

Students who have previously graduated from Central Linn who are continuing their education and have a 2.5 or higher GPA

The CLEA Scholarship totals \$1,500. Scholarship recipients may receive all or a partial amount of the scholarship total based on the discretion of the selection committee.

- Applicants must have been accepted to a post-high school institution, with the intent to earn a degree in a **social service** field of study such as <u>education</u>, <u>health care</u>, <u>social work</u>, <u>legal services</u>, <u>or community work</u>.
 - Applicants must designate the post-high school institution to which they have been accepted, and will be attending.
 - Applicants must provide proof of acceptance (a copy is acceptable).
 - If applicant is a post graduate and are already attending a post-high school institution, please also include your last year's transcript for proof of the GPA requirement.
- Applications must include:
 - A cover letter, with complete contact information addressed to CLEA
 Scholarship Committee, Central Linn High School, 32433 Hwy. 228, Halsey,
 OR 97348
 - Two letters of recommendation from any current or previous teachers, church or community members.
 - A typed, double spaced essay, (not to exceed two pages) explaining your goals in your chosen field of study.

Applicants may be asked to participate in an interview. During this interview, applicants will be asked to share how their high school record, activities, community service, and family activities support their intended field of study and the goals they have set for themselves.

Applications must be received no later than the last Thursday before Memorial Day.

Disbursement of funds will be placed directly into the recipient's student account in the institution they will be attending.
