Grading

Participation is the key to any successful music ensemble. Positive contribution in class with a good attitude will ensure that we have a great experience as we learn together.

Written Tests – Singing Tests and Projects will happen a few times each term to ensure retention of the material we discuss/music we learn. This may also include recorded testing.

All Performances are required. Missing a performance steals a moment from your choir-mates that can never be reclaimed. Therefore, an unexcused absence will lower a student's grade by two letters. However, we work very hard to avoid other school events and to openly communicate about conflicts etc. A written letter explaining an illness or emergency from a guardian or parent can work to avoid a lowering of your grade.

Formal Performance Attire

We will purchase our outfits in the first few weeks of school as agreed upon by the group. We can consider pushing this until later in the year as we understand the performance opportunities we will have better this year.
