Welcome

Welcome to Central Linn Online Academy (CLOA), a fully remote, self-paced K–12 learning program offered by the Central Linn School District. CLOA provides flexible, personalized education while keeping students connected to district resources and support.

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1. Program Overview

CLOA offers a flexible, self-paced online learning environment for students in grades K–12. Students can enroll full-time or part-time, maintaining access to district resources and extracurricular activities.

2. Enrollment & Eligibility

- **Eligibility:** Open to all K–12 students residing within the Central Linn School District.
 - **Enrollment Process:**
 - Complete the online registration form.
 - Select "Central Linn Online Academy" during registration.
 - A staff member will contact you to finalize enrollment.
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3. Curriculum & Instruction

- **Curriculum:** Central Linn Online Academy utilizes Greenways Academy for their online content. All classes have an Oregon licensed teacher and are aligned with the Oregon state standards.
 - **Instruction:**
 - Combination of asynchronous lessons and synchronous support sessions.
 - Access to certified teachers for guidance and assistance.
 - **Course Offerings:** Core subjects, electives, and advanced placement (AP) courses, depending on grade level.
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4. Technology & Materials

- **Technology Requirements:**
 - Reliable internet connection.
 - Compatible device (computer or tablet).
- **Materials Provided:**
 - Digital textbooks and resources.

- Physical materials for certain courses, as needed.
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 - **Technical Support:** Assistance available for technical issues related to the LMS and course access.
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5. Student Expectations

- **Attendance:**
 - Regular logins and consistent progress in coursework.
 - Participation in scheduled synchronous sessions.
 - **Academic Integrity:**
 - Adherence to the district's academic honesty policies.
 - Original work submission and proper citation of sources.
 - **Communication:**
 - Regular check-ins with teachers.
 - Prompt responses to communications from staff.
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6. Parent & Learning Coach Roles

- **Learning Coach Responsibilities:**
 - Support daily learning routines.
 - Monitor student progress and engagement.
 - Communicate with teachers and staff as needed.

- **Parent Involvement:**

- Ensure a conducive learning environment at home.
 - Encourage and motivate students.
 - Participate in parent-teacher conferences and school events.
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7. Assessment & Grading

- **Assessments:**

- Regular quizzes, tests, and assignments to gauge understanding.
- State-mandated standardized testing, as applicable.

- **Grading:**

- Based on assignment completion, participation, and assessment performance.
 - Progress reports and report cards issued per district schedule.
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8. Support Services

- **Academic Support:**

- Access to tutoring and additional resources.
- Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) and 504 Plans accommodated.

- **Counseling Services:**

- Academic and personal counseling available.
- College and career planning assistance.

- **Technical Support:**

- Helpdesk for technical issues related to the LMS and course materials.
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9. Policies & Procedures

- **Code of Conduct:**

- Students must adhere to the district's behavior expectations, even in a virtual setting.

- **Privacy & Security:**

- Compliance with FERPA and district policies regarding student data.

- **Non-Discrimination Policy:**

- The district prohibits discrimination based on race, color, national origin, sex, disability, or age in its programs and activities.
