Frequently Asked Questions

As part of our portfolio of student support, Central Linn School District offers an online option for students. Central Linn Online is a fully remote, self-paced online learning program available to students in grades K-12, with the flexibility to enroll either part-time or full-time. Even while participating in Central Linn Online, students remain fully connected to the district, retaining their school counselor to maintain strong ties to their home school. To ensure success in this program, students are required to demonstrate academic progress on a monthly basis and maintain weekly contact by completing assignments.

How and when do I enroll?

You may enroll by contacting Kellen Hobie at kellen.hobie@centrallinn.k12.or.us or by contacting your school counselor. You may enroll at any time.

What are the program requirements?

As a part of Oregon state requirements, students in Central Linn Online are required to make academic progress monthly and “attend” online classes weekly. “Attendance” is taken by completing tasks in the online platform.

Can students do partial time with Central Linn Online?

Yes! Students in grades 6-12 may take as few as one course or as many as five courses per trimester. Students in grades K-5 may take as few as a single content or as many as four contents. This makes Central Linn Online a great option for students who need a more tailored educational experience.

Does Central Linn provide technology and materials to the students?

Yes! Like all Central Linn students we provide a Chromebook for each student. In addition, we provide any and all materials that would be required for the online course; for example, if a digital camera is required, we will provide that as well.

Can I move faster through the courses? Can I take more than the “maximum” courses?

Yes! We allow you to move quickly through the courses. The benefits of a self-paced course is that you are able to “test-out” of the content at the start of the course— meaning, if you know the content, you are finished with it. You also are able to move as quickly or as slowly as you see fit. We do encourage you to finish your full set of courses before moving on to the next course as this ensures you can stay on track.

Can students still participate in all Central Linn activities?

Yes! Students are considered Central Linn students and can participate in all activities. Note: many activities require an ASB card, so your student(s) would still need that.

Will students stay on track to graduate?

Yes! Your student will keep their counselor when in Central Linn Online and the counselor will be listed as the “coach” online so they are continually getting updates about the student’s program and progress. Our counselors are the ones making the recommendations about which courses the student will be enrolled in so that your student stays on track for graduation.

Do I still have teachers?

Yes, but not a Central Linn district teacher. Central Linn Online teachers are fully remote and the responsibility of our online provider. Students will have an individual teacher per course/content.

Do I need to attend “live” classes?

No. With our online provider, there are “advisory” classes and “live” sessions that are more like “office hours” where students can go to get additional support. Students are not required to attend anything live.

Can students do College in High School?

Yes! We have a partnership with ASU through our online provider so students can take online ASU courses. A word of caution, though, not all ASU courses are direct transfers to Washington state universities; many transfer as electives. If you want to receive your AA degree or have courses that we know will transfer as “core requirement” courses, your best option is still our College in the High School in-person options.

How can I track how my student is doing?

Around the middle of the month, you will receive a progress report via email. In addition, each month you will receive progress monitoring emails per class.

What if I don’t like Central Linn Online and/or it doesn’t work for me?

If you find the program is not working for you, please contact Kellen Hobie at kellen.hobie@centrallinn.k12.or.us for support. You can leave Central Linn Online at any time, but we do want to make sure we are doing everything we can to ensure the program is a fit for you.

What will my student’s diploma say?

Your student’s diploma will say Central Linn High School.
