

Central Linn PackSnack Program FREE FOOD FOR YOUR CHILD

2021-2022

Sharing Hands and community members are working with Central Linn school staff to provide a **free supply of snacks** to students who may need an additional food resource over the weekends.

A small bag of shelf-stable food will be available to take home at the end of the school week. Elementary School PackSnacks are sent home weekly in students' backpacks. Students in grades 7-12 pick up their food weekly from a site at school staffed by volunteers and staff member Audrey Borders, the district Wellness Coordinator.

**Any child enrolled in CLSD may participate in the PackSnack Program.
There is no eligibility requirement.**

If you would like your child to receive a weekly PackSnack, please complete the consent form below and return it to your Central Linn school office. If you have more than one child in school, you only have to submit one form. This information will be kept confidential.

Once your consent form is received, your child's name will be added to the list of students registered for PackSnack. If PackSnack has sufficient funds, your child will soon begin to receive a supply of kid-friendly food each week.
